
OUR RESPONSE

With the situation changing rapidly, we've focused on staying flexible, taking care of our team members and clients, and doing our best to support our community.




We added a Kids section on our web site, creating fun learning activities for kids of all ages.




We've participated in virtual presentations to kids, including a Virtual Career Day with Crestridge Elementary School.



We organized a fun contest during Omaha Gives to encourage team members to support the organizations that need our help the most.


The raffle prize was getting to create and name an ice cream at Ted & Wally's!
